

Accommodation support

We understand the importance of having a safe and stable place to live.

Having somewhere you can call home is often the key that unlocks other areas in your life.

Our team can help you:

- Find somewhere to live if you have nowhere suitable or stable; and
- Resolve problems that might stop you from keeping the place you are currently living in.

How we can help you

We can:

- Guide you through your housing options;
- Put you in touch with the right providers;
- Help you understand your rights and responsibilities as a tenant;
- Help you fill out housing paperwork;
- Source furniture for your home; and
- Support you in accessing benefits you can claim.

As well as working with our accommodation officer, a volunteer will also support you. They will come along with you to your housing appointments and give you other practical advice.

Our sessions

We will meet with you to discuss and agree on what you need. With your input, we develop a plan that meets these needs.

Depending on your needs, you will be offered four to ten of our sessions. We can deliver support face-to-face, in group sessions, or over the telephone. How we deliver the support will be based on your needs and preferences.

We will discuss this with you at your first appointment.

Michael was facing homelessness when he was released from prison. An accommodation officer found him a flat. Later when he was having problems, the Officer also helped him to resolve his rent arrears.
